



"I.M.A.G.E. clones supplied by Source BioScience are cDNA clones imported from the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory. Unless explicitly stated otherwise, these clones are supplied as-is, direct from the original library and are not sequence-verified by Source BioScience. It is publicly accepted that up to 20% of the I.M.A.G.E. cDNA clones do not reflect the exact sequence associated with the respective clone identified by the I.M.A.G.E. Consortium, or can contain artefacts. Source BioScience recommends that the purchaser requests sequence-verification using the Source BioScience' Clone Identity Verification Service at the time of ordering any particular I.M.A.G.E. clone. This can be requested by selecting the sequence verified or purified plasmid clone format during the ordering process. If the requested clone does not match the expected sequence, Source BioScience will not apply any charge and will contact the purchaser to confirm if they wish to cancel the order. For the avoidance of doubt, it should be noted that Source BioScience excludes any warranty pertaining to the accuracy of the sequence for clone orders where the client chooses to reject the offered sequence verification option."
